<p>32 Budokan athletes competed in 44 divisions at the 2017 ACT International Open winning 19 medals</p> <p>7 x Gold, 5 x Silver, 7 x Bronze medals + 14 x /5th /7th /9th placings</p> <p>By comparison in 2016 22 athletes competed in 35 divisions winning 15 medals: 3 Gold, 4 Silver, 8 Bronze, 9 x 4th/5th and In 2015, 26 athletes competed in 42 divisions winning: 21 medals 7 Gold, 7 Silver, 7 Bronze, 3 x 4th/5th</p>

Some points about the competition:

- Mira Czarnetzki's U/44kg Junior Women's Division was not contested so she played in U/48kg
- Vanessa Hall accepted an invitation to compete in an O/78kg division because there was only 1 athlete in the Draw. She won the match but the result is not included in the above statistics.
- Of the 6 Cadets, 3 also competed in Junior Men/Women and 2 in Senior Men/Women
- All 7 of the Junior Men/Women competed in Senior Men/Women
- 129 matches were fought from 32 Budokan athletes in 44 divisions over 2 days
- 71 matches were won (55% of matches in which Budokan athletes competed)
- 19 medals were won and an additional 7 athletes fought for Bronze. This means 26 medal matches in 44 divisions (60%)
- 3 athletes had 8 matches in the day (Josh, Liam, Bjorn) and another 4 athletes had 6 or 7 matches (Kyle, Cameron, Zach, Amber), a benefit of competing in multiple age categories
