

QUICK GUIDE (with effect 1st January 2025) “Annual Judo (NSW) Membership” and “Budokan Judo Club Training Fees”

Introduction

This document is a brief summary of the registration process for Budokan Judo Club (Budokan) members, including Judo NSW membership and Budokan training fees. Detailed procedures are at <http://www.budokan-judo-club.com/judo-training-fees.html>

Judo NSW and Budokan

Judo NSW and Budokan are two separate legal entities. Budokan is affiliated with Judo NSW who operates under Judo Australia and the International Judo Federation. You are required to register as a financial member of Judo NSW and separately pay training fees to Budokan Judo Club. These are separate processes.

Before Stepping Onto the Mat

All new members must complete the following before participating in any club session:

1. Budokan Club Membership Form
2. Risk Warning and Waiver Form

Memberships

Both Judo NSW and Budokan Judo Club offer a **no-obligation one-month trial option** for new members. You can also elect to join immediately and become financial with Judo NSW and Budokan by paying the Judo NSW membership and club training fees before the expiry of the trial period. The following explains the options.

1. First training month

The **Trial Membership** for new Juniors and Seniors provides a **one month no-obligation training period, which includes insurance coverage**. All new members with the exception of children participating in the Dino Class (4 or 5 years old and not at school), must obtain a Trial Membership from Judo NSW before commencing classes at Budokan. Note that new student intakes **only occur in the first two weeks of each school term for the Monday Senior beginner class, and the Wednesday Dinosaurs, and Mons (turning 5-8 year old and at school)**. The Judo NSW membership for children participating in the Budokan Dino classes is called **Mini-Kids Membership** and focusses on pre-school pre-Judo education. **These children must purchase the Judo NSW \$50 annual Mini-Kids membership after the second Budokan session. They will have limited access to the Judo NSW programs and do not participate in Judo NSW gradings, tournaments and events; hence the cheaper membership, and the lack of trial period. For all other members, please don't obtain a "Trial Membership" from Judo NSW until JUST PRIOR to your first class, as the month trial period is triggered from this registration.**

Alternatively, you can go to <https://www.judonsw.com.au/> and select “Member Login”; and then select “Budokan” and then “New member”.

2. After the One-Month Trial Membership Period

a. Budokan Training Fees

During the Judo NSW Trial Period, Budokan Judo Club also includes a no-obligation one-month trial period for training. Should a new member continue to train after the one-month trial period, the Budokan training fee becomes due and is back-dated to the start of the trial period. Appendix 2 below provides all 8 available options and the list below is a summary:

2 age categories of fees: one for Dinosaurs (pre-school children aged 4 and 5 years), Mons (turning 5-8yo in the year and attending school), and Juniors (turning 9 to 14yo in the year), and another for Seniors (turning 15yo and older in the year)

2 training period intervals available: 3 or 12 months

Multiple family membership discounts for each of the above options.

Appendix-1 shows the various options for Budokan Training Periods, Classes and Family Discounts. **Appendix-2** provides more detail and examples of Budokan training fees, including terms and conditions of the purchase.

To purchase your training fee vouchers, go to <https://www.revolutionise.com.au/budokanjc/shop/> and select the appropriate training pass that applies to you or your child. A separate process is required for each child whereby you purchase one multiple family discount voucher for each child through a separate log in process. Note that Budokan training vouchers are not available in the Judo NSW virtual shop. b. Judo NSW Annual Membership

New members (school-aged children turning 5 or more in the year) must pay the [Judo NSW annual membership](#) when the Judo NSW Trial Membership expires. Go to: <https://www.revolutionise.com.au/budokanjc/registration/> to renew your membership. Active & Creative Kids vouchers can be used for Judo NSW payments.

c. NSW Government Active & Creative Kids Vouchers

Budokan Judo Club is a Provider under the **NSW Government Active & Creative Kids Program** which offers \$50 Active & Creative Kids Vouchers (AKVs) for school-enrolled children aged 4.5 to 18 years. Note Service NSW has some conditions for eligibility. For the use of the AKV against Budokan training fees, simply:

- a) Use your MyServiceNSW Account to apply for a voucher online from the Service NSW website at <https://www.service.nsw.gov.au/active-and-creative-kids-voucher>
- b) Please forward your Voucher details to Rob Katz at katzfamily@iinet.net.au on receipt
- c) Obtain a credit against your Purchase of Training Period Vouchers by selecting an AKV Voucher via the process in the next section.

Note: You must complete ALL of the above three activities to use the AKV discount for club training fees.

Appendix 1. Options for Training Periods, Classes and Family Discounts

Budokan Judo Club endeavours to provide our members with the best possible flexibility regarding training fee options.

Training Period Options

There are two training voucher options available for purchase, effective from the date of commencing training at the club, which includes the **no-obligation trial period**:

- Three (3) months
- Twelve (12) months

Discounts are offered to incentivise the purchase of longer training period vouchers.

Single Member vs Multiple Family Rate

Two training rates are available:

- **Standard rates for single** (one-only) family club membership
- **Multiple Family Discount** rates apply for more than one club member from the same family (parents or siblings only). Please note that if there is more than one family member purchasing Training Period Vouchers, the following applies:
 - Each family member must log in separately and use the below process
 - Once logged in, please only buy one **“Multiple Family Discount”** Voucher needed for that family member
- k) Where there is a current club member from a family who subsequently has other family member(s) wishing to join the club, simply purchase a **“Multiple Family Discount”** Voucher for each additional member for the period required. Provided there are two or more family members with current financial membership of Judo NSW, each is entitled to the **“Multiple Family Discount”** Voucher despite having different renewal dates or different period vouchers purchased. In the first instance please

Class Rates

Two class rates are available, distinguishing members who participate in the following categories of classes:

- The Dinos (Wednesday) class, for children who are 4 or 5 years old and NOT at school. They will have a “Mini-Kids” Judo NSW membership. MONS (Wednesday) class, for those turning 5 to 8 years in the year and are at school. Juniors (Tuesday/Thursday/Saturday) class, for those turning 9 to 14 years in the year. They will have a “Junior” Judo NSW membership. Saturday classes are for Junior and Senior Boys/Girls State Team members only.
- Seniors (Monday/Tuesday/Thursday/Saturday) for those turning 15 years or older in the year. They will have a “Senior” Judo NSW membership. Saturday classes are for Senior State Team members (Cadet and older).

Note: The definition of Junior and Senior at Budokan Judo Club is different from that used by Judo NSW in their registration, whereby Judo NSW uses 16 years of age (or older) at the time of registering as the cutoff.

Payment Rules

- The fee rates in the fee schedule apply irrespective of how often the member trains at the club
- Club training fees are paid online, not at the club
- Payment renewals are individualised, even if Multiple Family Discounts are used for more than one family joining at different times. This means that family members may have different training fee renewal dates. Appendix 2. Summary of Prices

| SINGLE RATES | 3 MTHS | 12 MTHS |

| Single Member – Senior Senior: Turning 15 in the year, or older | 350.00 | 850.00 |
| Single Member – Juniors, Mons, Dino Kids Mons: Turning 5 to 8 years in the year and at school Juniors: Turning 9 to 14 years in the year Dinos: 4 or 5 years old and <u>NOT</u> at school | 220.00 | 560.00 |

Discounts for either single or multiple family members from 3 to 12 months is approximately 40% (comparing 4 x 3 month payments).

MULTIPLE FAMILY MEMBERSHIP TRAINING FEES

Discounts for multiple family members compared to single member rates is approximately 20%.

A number of examples of the cost of different “Multiple Family” combinations follows below. When purchasing “Multiple Family” training vouchers, please log in separately for each family member and purchase 1 voucher for each family member so we can track for whom the purchase and payment applies. To calculate discounts for multiple family member

training fees, use the following example. Full price for 12 months for 1 x Senior and 2 x Juniors (per the above table) would be $\$850 + 2 \times \$560 = \$1970$ but fees are discounted for multiple family members as follows: $\$680 + 2 \times \$450 = \$1580$ (a saving of approximately 20%).
